

AARMS SUMMER SCHOOL - 2009

Information for Participants Arriving in Fredericton

Welcome to the 2009 AARMS Summer School at the University of New Brunswick in Fredericton.

Here is some advice about arriving by air in Fredericton. *Air Canada* daily offers several direct flights from Toronto (2 hr), Montreal (1 hr) and Halifax (1 hr). There is a less frequent flight from Ottawa. If you come from further afield, you will need to make a connection, most likely through Montreal or Toronto, and perhaps with one of Air Canada's Star Alliance Partners. Also, *Canadian Affair* offers a weekly charter flight from London, England.

Be sure to have necessary travel documents when you depart, and check these instructions for last minute updates.

It is worth booking your flight early to get the best price. It may pay to arrive a day or two early or leave a few days late; extra days in residence cost about \$24.00 per night (plus meals). To book these extra days yourself, please contact Ms. M. McLaughlin (misty@unb.ca or telephone (506) 453-4800).

As soon as your travel plans are complete, PLEASE let me (the director) know. We will try to meet you at Fredericton Airport. Look for someone with an AARMS Summer School sign.

If that doesn't work, take a taxi (about \$20.00 Canadian, one way, about 20 minutes) to the Residence Administration Office, 20 Bailey Drive, UNB Campus. (It is staffed 24 hours; but after 23:00 use the lobby phone.) You can locate this office using the campus maps and directory at:
